

Activities during 2025-26



19th January 2026: Students from a local nursing college gave detailed information on usage of Menstruation Cups and their benefits. The interactive session was started with questionnaire and with help of audio-visual methods complete information on usage of menstruation cup was given to remove apprehensions of female students.
